Dear Procurement Professionals,

On January 21, 2025, The White House issued the following Directive entitled "**Ending Illegal Discrimination and Restoring Merit-based Opportunity**".

Within that Directive you will see that, among the other previous Executive Orders revoked, Executive Order 11246, issued September 24, 1965, is revoked.

Within form [HUD 92010](#), "[Equal Employment Opportunity Certification](#)," you will see that the implementation of Executive 11246 is featured prominently therein.

It is my interpretation that the aforementioned Directive makes form HUD 92010 moot, so I accordingly will remove from my sample construction templates the utilization of form HUD 92010. I understand that the Directive from the White House does not specifically delete the usage of form HUD 92010; however, on the HUDClips Website this form HUD 92010 lists an expiration date of 4/30/2020, so since this form is over 5 years outdated (expired), this in my opinion is an easy decision to remove this form from usage for my sample construction IFBs.

To be clear, whereas I have no influence with the currently Administration as to these matters, I asked that readers consider this non-utilization of this form is my opinion and not based on a specific clear directive from HUD.

This immediate following statement is not to be construed to be any criticism of HUD (the situation "is what it is"), but with the recent substantial downsizing of HUD I actually have no idea who I could even contact to discuss this issue (and I am sure that the employees currently at HUD are pretty "swamped" and most likely do not have any more information on this matter than we have already been given).

I hope that this information is of a help.
